Four Patch Block




CUTTING FABRIC PIECES


Refer to the Cutting List on Page 3 to cut the fabric pieces. Location #1 may be cut as a square (3" x 3") or as a strip. If the strip is cut at a diagonal, the corners will be on the straight grain.


PIECING THE BLOCK

- Refer to Week 1 General Instructions and Week 8 - Crossed Canoes to piece the block. There are no diagonal intersections to match in this block, making assembly easy.
- 2. Press seams as shown in the diagram.



Open seam at center as shown in the photo below.

1	1½" x 4¼"	$\langle \rangle$
2, 3	31⁄8" x 31⁄8"	

Cut 45° angles from Location #1 as shown, or cut $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide diagonal strips from a 3" strip of fabric as shown below, and trim corners at 45° angles.
