

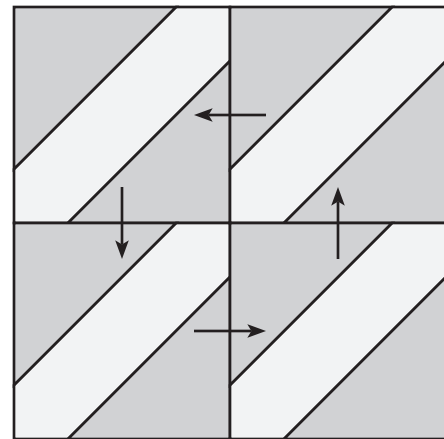
WEEK 20 - INDIAN HATCHETS

Four Patch Block

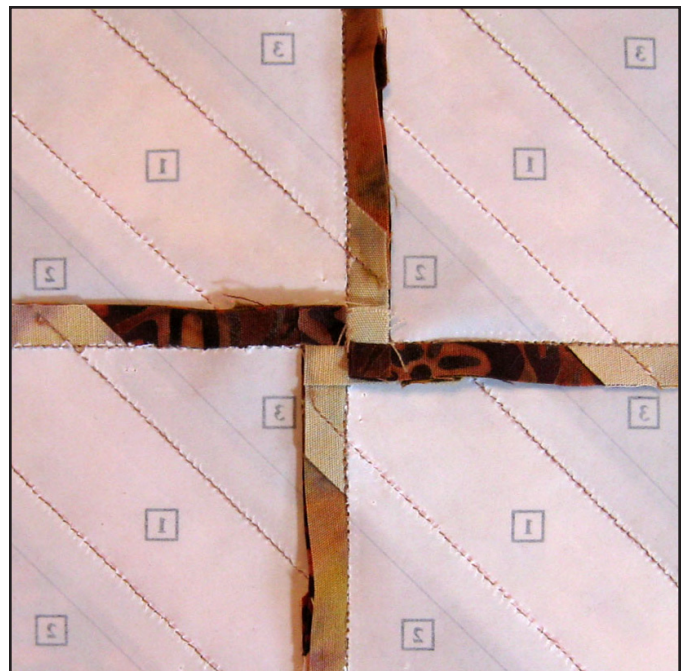


PIECING THE BLOCK

1. Refer to Week 1 General Instructions and Week 8 - Crossed Canoes to piece the block. There are no diagonal intersections to match in this block, making assembly easy.
2. Press seams as shown in the diagram.

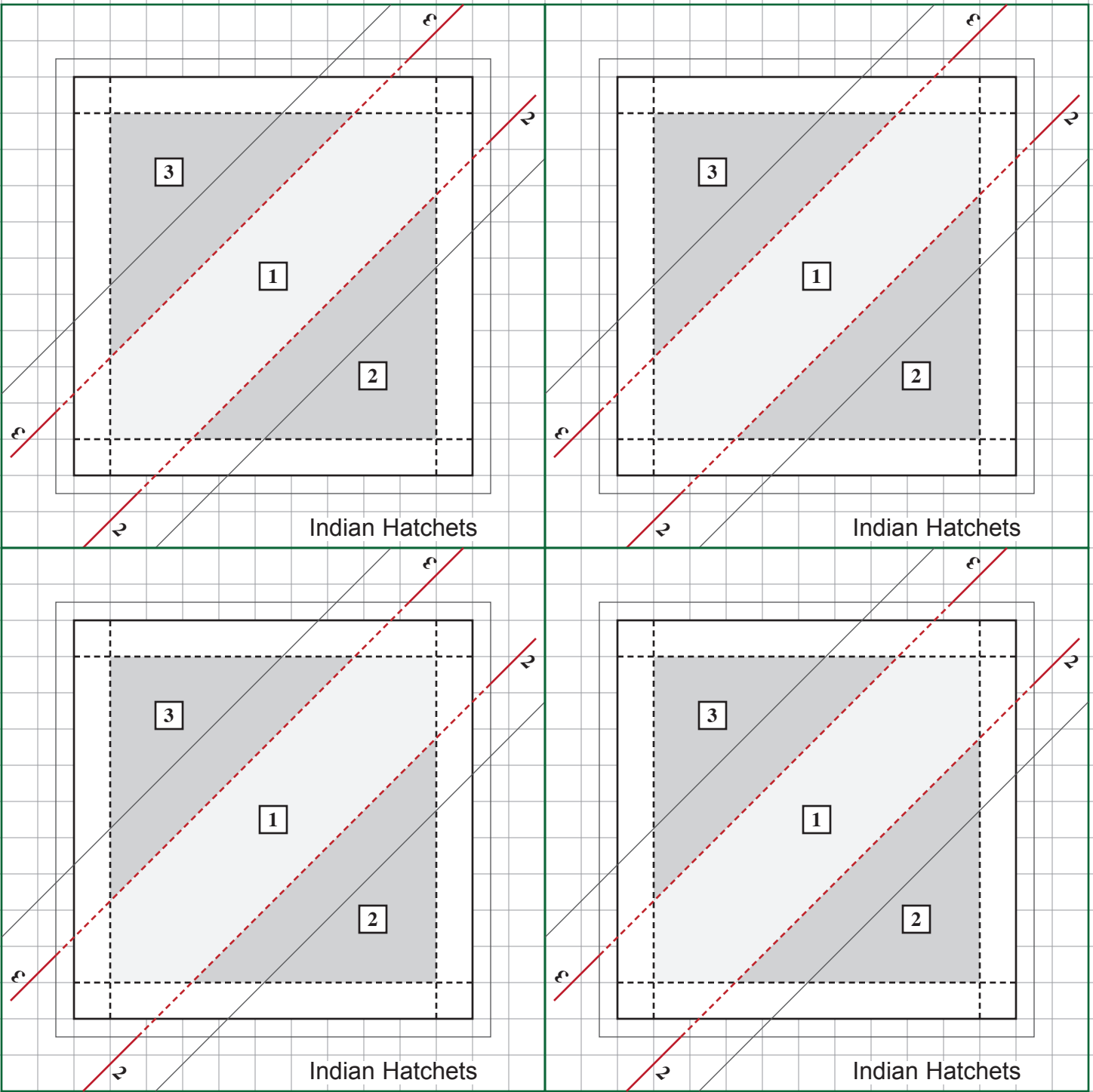


Open seam at center as shown in the photo below.



CUTTING FABRIC PIECES

Refer to the Cutting List on Page 3 to cut the fabric pieces. Location #1 may be cut as a square (3" x 3") or as a strip. If the strip is cut at a diagonal, the corners will be on the straight grain.

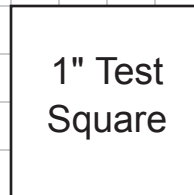
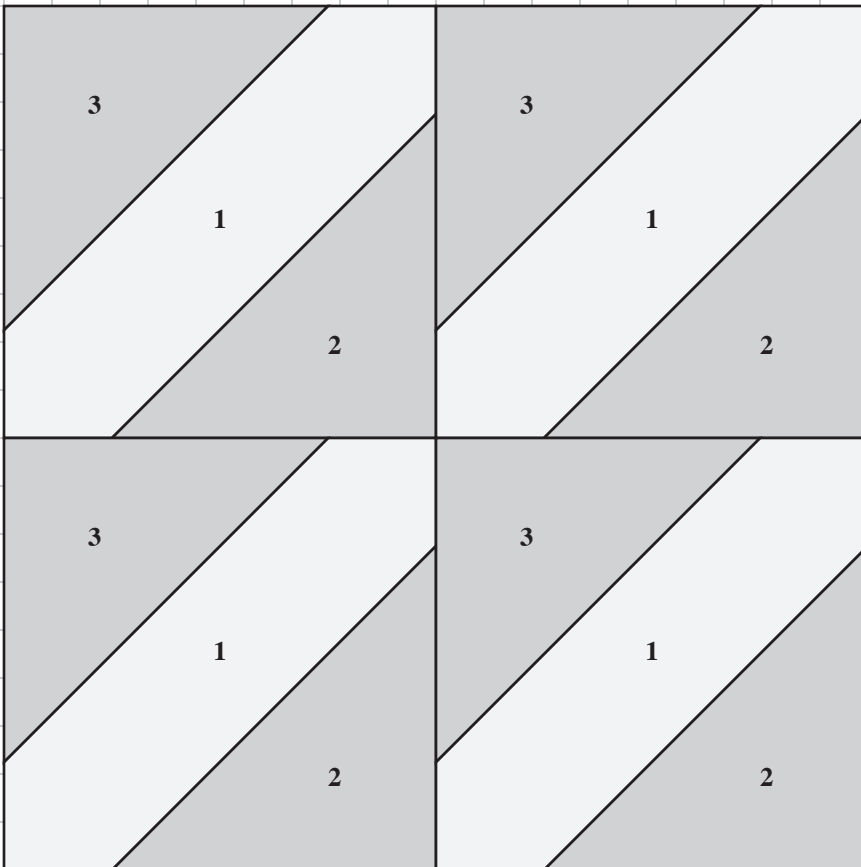
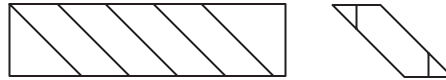

CUTTING LIST

Location	Size to Cut	
1	1½" x 4¼"	
2, 3	3⅛" x 3⅛"	

Cut 45° angles from Location #1 as shown, or cut 1½" wide diagonal strips from a 3" strip of fabric as shown below, and trim corners at 45° angles.



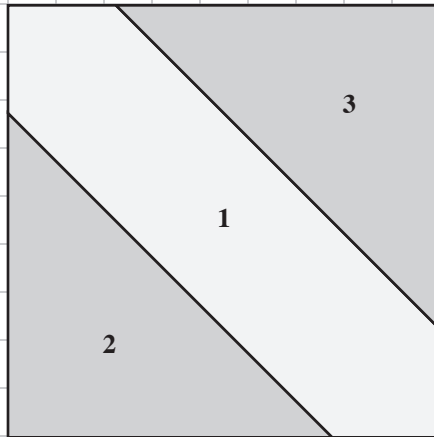
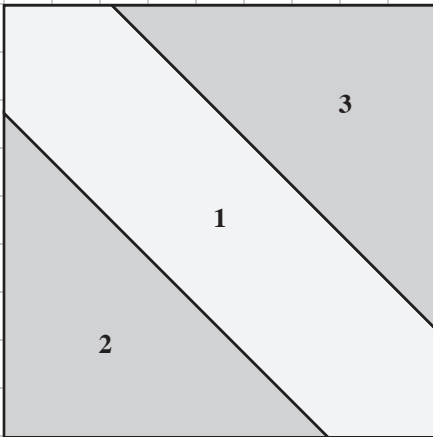
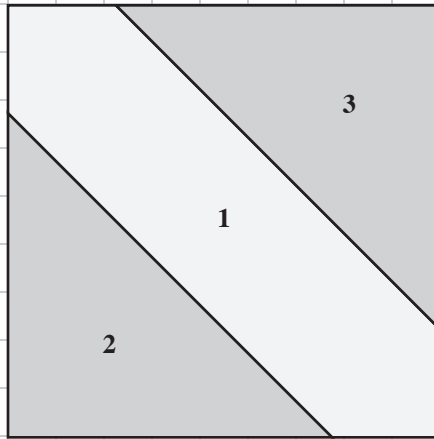
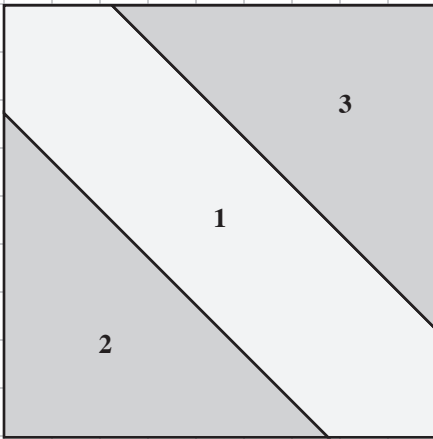
